



Itron, Inc. Conflict Minerals Policy Statement

At Itron, we apply our core values to our business every day. We are dedicated to creating a more resourceful world. Together with our customers, we work to improve the quality of life, safety and well-being of people everywhere. In support of our core values, Itron is committed to enabling a responsible and ethical environmental supply chain. We strive to develop products that make use of components and materials that are responsibly sourced and partner with suppliers that are committed to make that a priority as well.

Conflict minerals known as 3TGs are the minerals of tin, tungsten, tantalum and gold mined from the conflict region of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). Given the complexities of our supply chain and the multiple tiers between our company and the mines, we rely on our direct suppliers to determine the origin of the conflict minerals contained in our products.

Our due diligence process requires all supplier agreements include conflict mineral language in the Terms and Conditions and Supplier Code of Conduct (SCC). This includes our expectation that suppliers source conflict minerals from smelters and refiners that are compliant with the Responsible Mineral Initiative's assessment protocols. We request all new suppliers sign our standard terms and conditions and acknowledge the SCC to confirm their understanding of our expectations.

Itron can provide evidence of responsible sourcing upon request. In addition, we will continue to monitor the on-going development of industry practices related to the tracing and tracking of minerals, and thus, improving the transparency in our supply chain.
